**Tasks & Duties**

- The RN provides a high standard of direct and indirect age specific patient care..
- Demonstrate the needed knowledge and skills necessary to provide care to patients admitted to the Pediatrics, including medical and surgical cases.
- Able to meet clinical, educational, and quality patient outcomes, according to the hospital's policies, guidelines, and standards.
- Implements the nursing process independently (Performs assessment – puts forth nursing diagnosis – elaborates a care plan – implements nursing care – evaluates its adequacy and amends care plan). Receives and greets patient and family into the unit, introduces self and provides orientation.
- Interviews patient collects health history.
- Performs complete physical assessment upon admission, every shift & whenever patient's condition changes.
- Monitors vital signs and symptoms/reactions that may occur during or as a result of the course of treatment.
- Identifies patient's actual health problems, risk factors and needs; puts forth nursing diagnosis
- Ensures that patient rooms are well maintained and prepared.
- Performs daily and every shift quality assurance and availability checks on the unit's narcotics stock, equipment reserve and inventory. Reports discrepancies, malfunctions and missing equipment to the direct superior.
